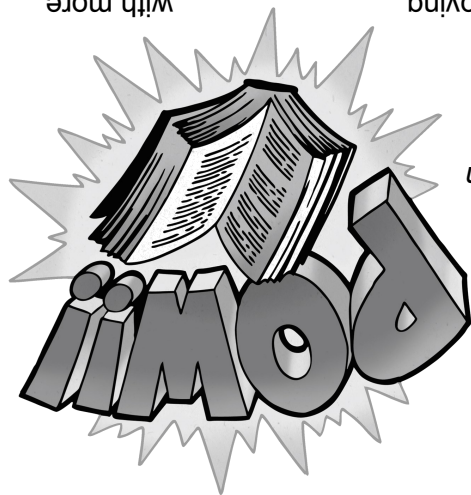




**A library card is available for youth 18 years and younger at no cost to you.*

Since learning can happen at any time and in many ways, we want you to connect with the library as an access point for further learning this summer. So, although reading and listening to books still count, we're asking you to find learning options (*maybe you'll even want to read them!*) at the library connected to **ANY** of your activities or experiences or challenges this summer. This might be a related book, a magazine or newspaper article from one of our databases, or letting us know that we don't own a particular book that you've read. You may repeat the experience, but you must pick a **different resource each time**. You can do this at the library or online from where ever you have internet access.

*NOTE: The internet in general and other websites do **NOT** count. Only interactions through our library's resources may be used for the Learning Options that aren't reading or listening to a book.*

example	Traveled to Brazil	[Hint: check out our <i>Global Road Warrior</i> database or our <i>Mango Language</i> database for learning languages]
example	Went to the animal shelter to pet cats	BOOK: The Allure of the Cat 636.8 Gebhardt 1992
example	Worked on repairing my car	Found [what?] in Library's <i>Chilton Repair</i> database
example	Volunteered at the hospital	eBook: Inside Oregon State Hospital
